RE: Response to proposed Scheduling Conference Report dated July 16, 2004

Dear Ms. Ford:

Please note our objection to this last minute effort to comply with the court order of April 14, 2004. As you are aware, we informed you in mid May that we would be out of town from July 5<sup>th</sup> to July 19 and would appreciate having the required meeting prior to June 29<sup>th</sup>. However, in an effort to meet the dead line of Tuesday, July 20<sup>th</sup>, as stated in your telephone message of July 16<sup>th</sup>, we make the following requests:

Page 1, line 25 a. Short synopsis of main claim. Last sentence changed to read:

“Plaintiffs contend that common law-labor for hire- wages, as annual receipts, are not net-income subject to Title 26, Subtitle A, subsection 61 (a) (1) reporting requirements; nor does the performance of common labor for hire constitute “personal services” rendered in payment for “compensation for services” as required by the cited Statute.

Page 2, Line 15 d. Realistic range of provable damages. Change the quotation to:

“WAGES NOT SUBJECT TO INCOME TAX PER ATTACHMENT A”

Page 3, line 4 i. Proposed Discovery Cut-off Date. Change to read

The parties propose a discovery cut-off date of September 30, 2004.

Page 3, line 7 j. Description of issues or claims for summary judgment. Delete

Page 3, line 10 k. Contemplated law and motion and proposed motion cut-off date.  
Change to read:

The parties propose a discovery cut-off date of September 30, 2004

Page 3, line n. Proposed dates. Beginning at line 22

Discovery cut-off: September 30, 2004

Motions filed cut-off: November 1, 2004

Motions heard cut-off: December 15, 2004

Pre-trial conference: January 31, 2005

Trial: July 31, 2005
